

## COVID Guidelines Updated

Per Bishop Doyle's recent statement, St. Christopher's updated Covid guidelines will *continue to reflect the need to protect those who are immunocompromised or otherwise unvaccinated*, as follows:

- Because our church family consists of both fully vaccinated and non-vaccinated people, all unvaccinated people (who aren't 2 years and younger!) are expected to *always* wear masks indoors.
- Because we have no way to confirm a person's vaccination status, but it appears that most of us are vaccinated, while we worship, those who are not vaccinated are asked to voluntarily seek seating that allows for social distancing.
- Until Bell County is ranked by the CDC, as "Low" for community transmission, we will not use a Common Cup and therefore will not serve wine at communion.
- Singing is encouraged, *but* we will sing while keeping in mind these updated guidelines.
- Even outdoors, smart social distancing is encouraged.
