Communion Wine in the Intinction Cup

We have added an LEM/Chalice Bearer to assist Fr. Steve, using an "Intinction" Cup.
We will not sip from the common cup, but we will have wine!

Intinction: the act of dipping the bread in the wine at a Eucharist.

Please remember that only the wafer (and not your fingers!) should touch the wine.
