What is Baby Bottle Boomerang?

[Baby Bottle Boomerang](#) is an annual fundraiser that provides life-affirming services to those facing unplanned pregnancy. Last year, Church congregations around the Killeen, Temple, Copperas Cove communities were able to collect over \$55,000 in cash, checks and coins! Each donation helps to provide free pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, education, baby supplies AND the Good News of the Gospel to women and men in need of hope and healing.

How Does it Work?

Baby bottles are distributed to churches, schools, businesses, groups, and individuals from Mother's Day to Father's Day. Bottles can be filled with change, cash, and even checks!
