Current Church Projects the Vestry is working on:

We have received a settlement check from Tex-Air Delivery Company for damage to the parking lot. The repairs will be done by Integrity Paving and they will do everything they can to bring that repair in for the amount received, but there may be cost overruns.

We also have repairs to the pews still needing to be done. We are replacing broken or missing pads (underneath, where kneelers touch the floor), and we have one pew which is not in use at this time because it is not stable. We will have pews repaired in the next few weeks.
